### **DG ELARG – 20<sup>th</sup> March 2013** Media Evaluation Summary Report

#### **Summary**

Serbia did its best to reach a compromise in the dialogue with Kosovo, according to Marko Durić the Serbian President's foreign policy advisor on Radio Television of Serbia (RTS) According to Durić "It is up to the countries of the international community which have influence over Pristina and are able to exert pressure on it" (focus-fen.net, BG, 19/3). UN Secretary General Ban Ki-moon is to meet with the prime ministers of Kosovo and Serbia in New York within the framework of the debates on Kosovo during the UN Security Council meeting writes KS Reporter, and picked up by focus-fen.net (BG, 19/3). The UN Security Council will debate on Kosovo on Friday, March 22, two days after the seventh round of the negotiations between Belgrade in Pristina held in Brussels. European Commissioner for Enlargement, Štefan Füle, said during his visit to the Serbian capital city "I am well-aware that everyone is interested in whether Serbia will be given a date to start the negotiations for its EU accession. This depends on the efforts the country makes in the realisation of the reforms, as well as on the progress registered in the negotiations with Kosovo" (focus-fen.net, BG, 19/3). Ansa.it (IT, 19/3) also quoted Füle: "If Kosovo and Serbia finally iron out their differences at what will be their seventh round of talks tomorrow, this could be a first step toward Kosovo's EU integration". The Serbian President added "the country deserves starting date of negotiations for accession to the EU" (kerdos.gr, EL, 19/3).


